RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2040 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND FISCAL YEAR 2017 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AMENDMENT TO INCLUDE IN PRIORITY I THE PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENVIRONMENTAL (PD &E) PHASE FOR THE STRATEGIC MIAMI AREA RAPID TRANSIT (SMART) PLAN EAST-WEST (SR 836) CORRIDOR, WITH PROJECT LIMITS FROM MIAMI INTERMODAL CENTER (MIC) TO FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (FIU)

WHEREAS, the MPO Governing Board Chair has emphasized a renewed sense of urgency to improve transit mobility options with the creation of the Transit Solutions Committee (TSC) and the Fiscal Priorities Committee (FPC); and

WHEREAS, the TSC and the FPC are responsible for identifying immediate opportunities to advance and prioritize funding for mass transit services; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution #06-16, the MPO Governing Board established a policy to set as highest priority the advancement of rapid transit corridor projects in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution #26-16, the MPO Governing Board endorsed the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan and directed the MPO Executive Director to include in Priority I the PD&E Phase for the SMART Plan East-West (SR 836) Corridor, with project limits from Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) to Florida International University; and

WHEREAS, the East-West (SR 836) is one of the six (6) corridors endorsed by the MPO Governing Board under MPO Resolution #26-16 for conducting the PD&E; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2016, the FPC recommended amending the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan and the Fiscal Year 2017 Transportation Improvement Program to include in Priority I the Project Development & Environmental (PD &E) phase for the East-West (SR 836) Corridor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE MIAMI URBANIZED AREA, that the attached amendment to the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan and FY 2017 Transportation Improvement Program to include in Priority I the Project Development & Environmental (PD&E) Phase for the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan East-West (SR 836) Corridor, with project limits from Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) to Florida International University (FIU) is hereby approved.
