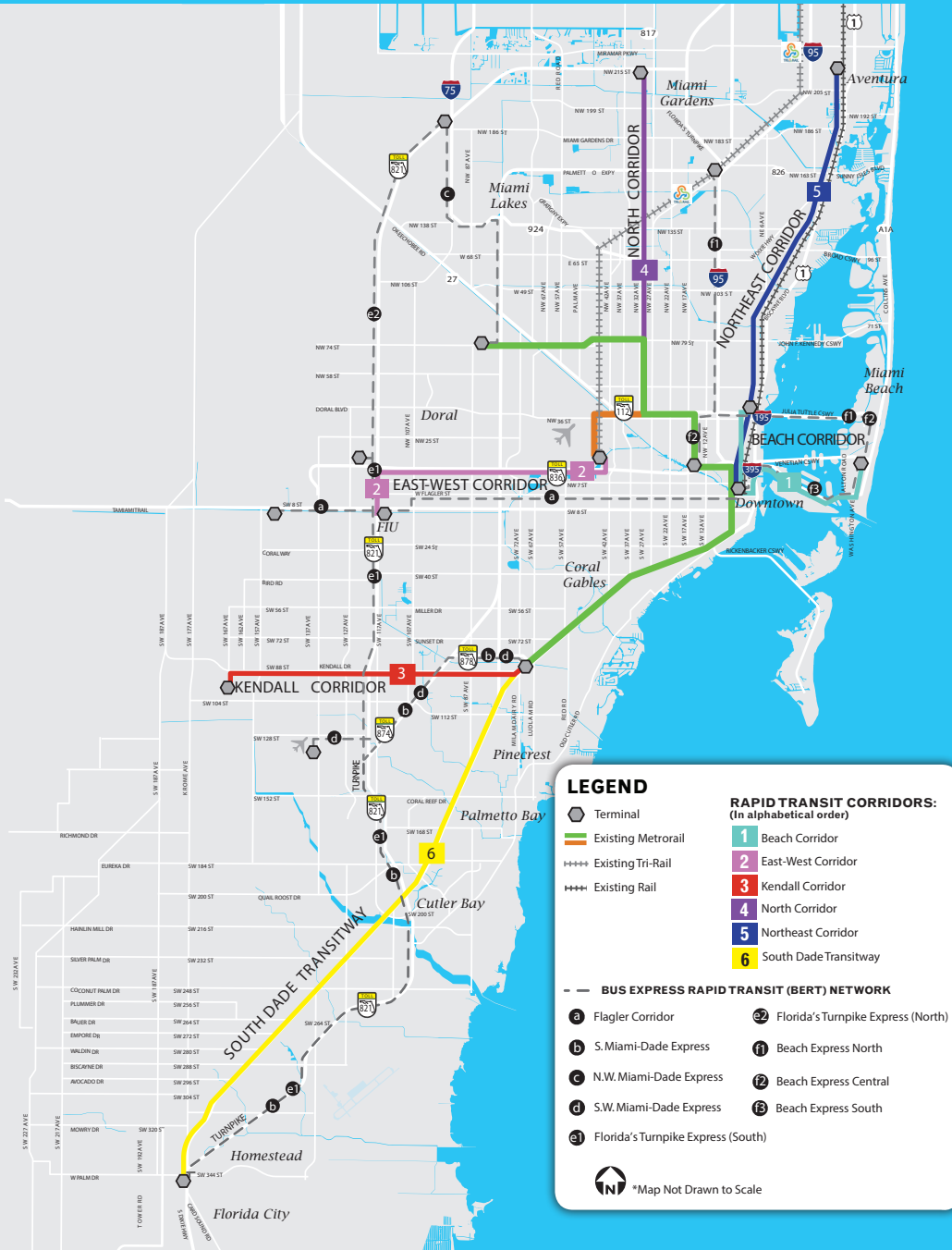
MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IS GETTING SMART ABOUT

It all starts with a plan. The Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit Plan - also known as the SMART Plan - has been set in motion and will transform transportation in Miami-Dade County. The strategy involves expanding public transit into six rapid transit corridors and supported by a bus express rapid transit network. The SMART Plan will be made possible by the partnership between the Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW), the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX), and the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT).
