RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STRATEGIC MIAMI AREA RAPID TRANSIT (SMART) PLAN TO EXTEND THE LIMITS OF BUS EXPRESS RAPID TRANSIT (BERT) NETWORK CORRIDOR, IDENTIFIED AS FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE EXPRESS (NORTH), TO CONNECT TO THE NORTH CORRIDOR, AND URGING FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE ENTERPRISE TO ASSUME FULL FUNDING FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THIS BERT CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement creating and establishing the Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Miami Urbanized Area, now known as the Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), requires that the TPO provide a structure to evaluate the adequacy of the transportation planning and programming process; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution #06-16, the TPO Governing Board established a policy to set as highest priority the advancement of rapid transit corridor projects in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution #26-16, the TPO Governing Board endorsed the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan, which includes six (6) rapid transit corridors and a network of bus express rapid transit (BERT) corridors throughout Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the North Corridor is one of the six SMART Plan rapid corridors, which limits are from NW 79th Street to NW 215th Street, along NW 27th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, under TPO Resolution #23-17, the current SMART Plan limits for the BERT Florida's Turnpike Express network extends from SW 344 Street Transitway Station to the Florida's Turnpike Express I-75 Park and Ride; and

WHEREAS, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is in the process of widening the Homestead Extension of the Florida's Turnpike (HEFT) to create managed lanes; and

WHEREAS, traffic congestion in the northwest quadrant of Miami-Dade County has rapidly risen and will continue to increase as significant commercial, industrial, and residential projects are under various stages of development; and

WHEREAS, an extension of the BERT Florida's Turnpike Express network to the northwestern portions of Miami-Dade County to connect to the North Corridor, coupled with the HEFT managed lane concept will provide transit connectivity and enhanced mobility options for motorists traveling in the northwest quadrant of the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION IN ITS ROLE AS THE MPO FOR THE MIAMI URBANIZED AREA, that this Board hereby amends the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan to extend the limits of the bus express rapid transit (BERT) network corridor, identified as the Florida's Turnpike Express (North), to connect to the North Corridor, in substantially the form attached, and urges Florida's Turnpike Enterprise to assume full funding for the operation and maintenance of this BERT corridor.

The adoption of the foregoing resolution was sponsored by Board Member Barbara J. Jordan and moved by Board Member Joe A. Martinez. The motion was seconded by Board Member Jose "Pepe" Diaz, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
