With almost 30 years of public and private sector experience, Ms. Bouclé is a driven transportation leader with extensive knowledge and expertise in transportation planning, including project development and environmental phases, as well as local, state, and federal funding requirements. She is the Executive Director of the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), focused on advancing the directives of the TPO Governing Board to expand mobility options and the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit “SMART” Plan.

Ms. Bouclé has been appointed as TPO Trustee Member on the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Board, as well as to The Underline Board of Directors. In addition, Ms. Bouclé is active on a statewide level with the Florida MPO Advisory Committee (MPOAC), as well as several national organizations, including the American Public Transportation Association (APTA), National Association of Metropolitan Planning

Organizations (AMPO), and American Planning Association (APA), attaining the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) designation. She has also been nominated and elected by her peers as Second Vice Chair of the Executive Directors Council for the National Association of Regional Councils (NARC).

Ms. Bouclé formerly served as the Intermodal Systems Development Administrator with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), responsible for the Transportation Planning Office, Concept Development Unit, Environmental Management Office, and the Freight Logistics and Passenger Operations Office, specializing in all modes of transportation including transit, aviation, seaport, rail, freight, pedestrian, bicycle, highway/roadway, and intermodal facilities. She was also formerly the Miami-Dade County School Board MPO Coordinator responsible for advancing student related transportation needs. During her public sector career, she advanced high-profile projects as the 95 Express, I-395 and PortMiami Tunnel, as well as commuter, transit, and other pedestrian and multi-modal projects in Southeast Florida.

Ms. Bouclé’s private sector experience includes Senior Planner with a consulting firm involved in all aspects of transportation development, including land-use, project development, environment, right-of-way, and traffic forecasting. She began her career as a Business Analyst with Dun & Bradstreet Corporation, developing a strong base in business and real estate.
